The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.88, dated 13.06.2022 registered under Sections 323/324/148/149 of the IPC (with Section 326 added later on), at Police Station Sadar, Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions, submits that pursuant to the orders dated 22.07.2022 and 21.04.2023 the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the orders dated 22.07.2022 and 21.04.2023 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner are made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
