DEEPAK GUPTA J. (ORAL)

1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is to direct respondents No.2 to 7 to ensure that the petitioner and his other family members are not implicated in cross case i.e., DDR No.40, dated 22.12.2021, under Sections 302, 323, 427, 148, 149 IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur in case FIR No.116, dated 20.12.2021, under Sections 302, 307, 34 IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur.
2. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that inquiries were already conducted twice and the cross case was found to be false but now respondents No.8 and 9 have moved fresh application to conduct the inquiry, which is being conducted by respondent No.6 in violation of the instructions dated 01.04.2008 (Annexure P-6) issued by respondent No.2.
3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 7 only at this stage.

4. At the asking of the Court, Mr. M. S. Tiwana, Asstt. A.G., appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 7-State. He, on instructions from Inspector Hardeep Singh-respondent No.6, submits that investigation is under way only in respect of the main FIR and not qua the cross version.

5. In view of the aforesaid statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition stands disposed of, as no further relief is asked for.
