Petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.283 dated 27.08.2011, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 307, 323, 379-B, 382, 148 and 149 of IPC and under Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar, wherein he is facing prosecution.

2. Counsel for the petitioner would submit that despite the fact FIR was registered on 27.08.2011, the charges could be framed on 23.03.2022 and even thereafter the trial has failed to proceed further as no PW has come in Court.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. Having heard counsel for the parties, I am of the considered opinion that definitely the petitioner would have a right to speedy trial.

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6. In view of the above, present petition is disposed off with a direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial finally within a period of 09 months from the date of receipt of certificate copy of the order.
