By way of the instant petition, the petitioner has sought the relief of anticipatory/pre-arrest bail in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.191 dated 30.03.2023 registered at Police Station City Fatehabad, District Fatehabad, under Sections 363 and 366 IPC.

2. Today, learned State counsel, on the instructions from SI Chander Kanta from the above-referred Police Station, informs the Court that in compliance of the order as passed by the Co-ordinate Bench on 12.06.2023, the petitioner has joined in the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required and moreover, he is also not involved in any other criminal case. He has also submitted reply on behalf of the respondent-State (by way of the affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, HQ, Fatehabad, District Fatehabad), along-with Annexures R-1 to R-4 and the vernacular versions of

Annexures R-1 to R-3, in the Court today and all these documents are taken on the record.

3. In view of the afore-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to the petitioner named Amit Kumar @ Amit by the Co-ordinate Bench vide the said order dated 12.06.2023, is hereby made absolute.

4. However, the petitioner shall continue to join in the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
