This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to the official respondents to conduct fair and impartial inquiry/investigation upon FIR No.138 dated 06.08.2020 under Sections 306/34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Jatusana, District Rewari.

On issuance of notice of motion status report dated 16.03.2021 by way of affidavit of Mukesh Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Kosli, District Rewari, has been filed wherein the following averments have been made:-

*“9. That in the present case the accused Maya Devi wife of Mamchand resident of Dahina Police Station Khol, Mahipal son of Mamchand resident of Dahina Police Station Khol and Billu @ Birender son of Nihal Singh resident of Bass Sub-Tehsil Manethi, District Rewari have filed a bail application under Section 438 Cr.PC before the Court of Sh. Dinesh Kumar Mittal, Sessions Judge, Rewari and the same was dismissed vide order dated 21.09.2020.*

10. That the accused Maya Devi wife Mamchand resident of Dahina Police Station Khol, Mahipal son of Mamchand resident of Dahina

*Police Station Khol and Billu @ Birender son of Nihal Singh resident of Bass Sub-Tehsil Manethi, District Rewari have filed anticipatory bail application under Section 438 Cr.PC before this Hon'ble High Court of Punjab and Haryana at Chandigarh bearing number CRM-M-32674-2020. The Hon'ble Justice Jaishree Thakur vide order dated 14.10.2020 passed following order:*

*“Meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to join the investigation within a period of one week and on their doing so, the petitioners be released on interim bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”*

*The present case is now listed for 22.02.2021.*

*11. That in compliance of the order dated 14.10.2020 the accused appeared on 20.10.2020 before the investigation officer and presented the copy of aforesaid order and accordingly were joined in investigation. The accused were arrested with due process and were released on bail by the investigation officer after furnishing the requisite bail bonds.”*

Learned State counsel submits that thereafter challan has also been presented in the present case.

In view of the above, counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Accordingly the present petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.
