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The matter has been discussed with the learned counsel for the parties. They have arrived at a settlement as per their statements.

Learned counsel for the claimants submitted that Meena Devi, Proforma respondent No.5 and mother of the deceased has since died. He also submitted that Dikshant, minor son of the deceased has also expired and that he has placed on record an affidavit of proforma respondent No.4-Megha D/o Ramesh Kazal, that she has no objection if the entire enhanced amount for & on behalf of all the claimants including herself is paid to appellant No.1-Sunita Kazal.

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.14,00,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellants. Learned counsel further submitted that the entire enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.1-Sunita Kazal Wd/o Shri Ramesh Kazal, for & on behalf of all the claimants, in full & final satisfaction of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque in the sum of Rs.14,00,000/- favouring appellant No.1-Sunita Kazal Wd/o Shri Ramesh Kazal, with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court

on or before 01.04.2023. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
