The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for anticipatory bail and release the petition on bail in the even of his arrest in FIR No.67 (Annexure P-1) dated 02.07.2023 registered under Section 406. 498-A, IPC at Police Station Women Cell, District Ludhiana, Punjab.

The petitioner was granted interim bail by this Court and thereafter the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, Ludhiana and learned counsel for the petitioner submits that an application has been filed under Section 13-B before the Competent Court for mutual divorce on the basis of the compromise arrived at between the parties. Taking into consideration the aforesaid aspects I am inclined to allow anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and is directed that in the eventuality of arrest of the petitioner in the instant case, he shall be enlarged on anticipatory bail subject to his furnishing personal bond/surety
