SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. On the previous date of hearing, this Court had directed the learned counsel for U.T. Chandigarh to seek, and, to place on record instructions with respect to the possibility of the present petitioner being rehabilitated at some other site. Learned counsel for U.T. Chandigarh has taken, and, purveyed instructions to this Court, that the respondent is willing to rehabilitate the petitioner, at the site disclosed (in green colour) in the site plan of 01.04.2022. The said site plan has been placed today before this Court, and, the same is taken on record.

2. He has also assured this Court, that the compensation in terms of the relevant scheme shall also be determined in respect of the structures existing on the acquired land. He also assures this Court, that both the

allotment of the alternative site as well as, the determination of compensation in respect of the structures existing on the acquired land, shall be made positively within 3 months.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions purveyed to him by the petitioner is in agreement with the above submission addressed before this Court.

4. In consequence, nothing survives in the writ petition. Therefore, the instant petition is disposed of as having become rendered infructuous. However, in terms of the instructions purveyed and accepted by this Court as well as, by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court directs the respondent to do all the above within a period of 3 months hereafter.

5. Disposed of accordingly.
