DEEPAK GUPTA J. (ORAL)

1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.69, dated 24.02.2021, under Sections 323, 506, 509, 34 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Baldev Nagar, District Ambala.
2. It is revealed that petitioner was on regular bail. He absented from trial on 07.03.2022, due to which his bail was cancelled and warrants of arrest were issued against him.
3. It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner was not informed correctly the date of hearing by his counsel. He further contends that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court.
4. Notice of motion.
5. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Randhir Singh, Addl. A.G., Haryana appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

6. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court on or before 03.07.2023, i.e., the date stated to be already fixed there at, subject to the condition that prior thereto, he shall deposit costs of Rs.25,000/- in the DLSA, Ambala. On his such surrender, he shall be admitted to bail by the trial Court concerned. In case the petitioner fails to make compliance of any of the condition, this order will have no effect. In case on account of warrant of arrest having been issued against the petitioner, he is sought to be arrested in the meantime, he shall be admitted to interim bail.
7. Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of.
