1. The petitioner appears in person. The litigation between the petitioner and his wife is on account of marital discord. The Family Court, in the facts and circumstances of the present case, has ordered clubbing of the proceedings of the separate petitions filed under Section 13 and 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955. The petitioner claims that the evidence in the divorce petition has already been recorded and therefore the court should read the same evidence in petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.

2. After arguing for some time, the petitioner, who appears in person, prays for permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file an appropriate application before the Family Court, at the first instance.

3. Ordered accordingly.

4. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
