The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.106 dated 17.7.2022, under Section 306 IPC, registered at Police Station GRP, Ludhiana.

On 12.6.2023, this Court had passed the following order

:-

“Contends, inter-alia, that petitioner is more than 78 years of age.

Notice of motion

Mr. Ferry Sofat, Addl. AG, Punjab, accepts notice and seeks time to have instructions in the matter.

Posted on 03.08.2023.

In the meanwhile, petitioner shall join investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit her to interim bail, till the next date of

hearing, on furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner shall also abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rakesh Kumar states that in terms of the order passed by this Court, reproduced above, the petitioner has joined the investigation and no further interrogation is required at this stage.

In view of the above, the order dated 12.6.2023 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join the investigation and cooperate with the investigating agency in case he is required for the same in future as and when called upon to do so.

In case at any given point of time hereinafter, it is felt by the investigating agency that the petitioner is required for the investigation but is not cooperating, they will be at liberty to approach this Court for passing appropriate orders.

The petition stands disposed of.
