On 12.06.2023, the following order was passed by this

Court:-

“Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0175 dated 14.08.2022 registered under Sections 406, 408, 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

FIR was lodged on the complaint of one Rajesh Mehru against petitioner and co-accused Gaurav Aggarwal and Dinesh Kumar.

It is contended by learned counsel that it was a business transaction between the parties and matter has since been compromised between the parties. Copy of that compromise/ settlement deed is dated 24.01.2023 (Annexure P.2). Learned counsel further submits that quashing petition i.e. CRM-M-6687 of 2023 in respect of FIR in question has already been filed which is fixed before this Court for 03.08.2023.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Navneet Singh, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent- State.

Adjourned to 03.08.2023.

To be heard along with CRM-M-6687 of 2023.

In the meantime, in case of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/ Investigating Officer. However, it is further directed that

the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when so required by the Investigating Officer. He shall not contact any person associated with the case to dissuade him from the investigation in any manner whatsoever and nor shall leave the country without prior permission of the Court. He shall further comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

On instructions from ASI Jagjeet Singh, learned State counsel has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 12.06.2023 and is no longer required for further investigation.

In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 12.06.2023, whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, he shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
