MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

By means of this writ petition filed under Article 226 Constitution of India petitioner has prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the orders dated 04.04.2007 and 13.07.2007 (Annexures P-1 and P-2, respectively) passed by respondent No.2, whereby she was removed from the services after imposing major penalty proceedings under Rule 25 General Insurance (Conduct, Discipline and Appeal) Rules, 1975.

After filing of this writ petition on 20.07.2022, petitioner appeared only to seek adjournment on 28.07.2022. Thereafter, the case was listed on 08.02.2023, but again prayer for adjournment was made. Today also a similar request for adjournment has been made. This reflects complete lack of interest in the writ petition. Consequently, this Court is not inclined to adjourn the writ petition.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
