1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking grant of post-arrest bail in:-

2. Custody Certificate dated 12.09.2023 has been filed by the State, which is taken on record.

3. As per the Custody Certificate, petitioner has been in custody for the last one year and two months. Petitioner was allegedly found to be in possession of 1600 tablets of Alprasafe-0.5, which concededly falls within the ambit of commercial quantity as per notification issued under the NDPS Act.

4. After addressing for some time, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition.
