Through the instant writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner is seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for the release of alleged detenues, mentioned in para No.4 of the petition, from the illegal detention of the private respondents No. 5 to 7.

Learned State on instructions from Sanjay Kapoor, Junior Assistant, has informs that necessary compliance has already been done and that the statement of the alleged detenues was recorded wherein they have stated that the Labour had not been kept as bonded. It is also stated that the dispute pertained to a monetary dispute amongst the parties and that the labourer have thereafter left on their own accord for panipat. The said status report is taken on record.

In view of the aforesaid statement, the present writ petition

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is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
