VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to issue the roll number to the petitioner for appearing in the examination for B.Sc (Nursing) Ist Year.

2. Learned counsel appearing for respondent no.2 has submitted that the petitioner has completed her course of B.Sc. Nursing and has already been given the degree and the respondent-institute is not contemplating to take any action against the petitioner and fully recognises the degree in favour of the petitioner and has submitted that since the relief has already been granted to the petitioner and no action is sought to be taken against the petitioner, the present petition be disposed of as having

been rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the statement made by contesting respondent no.2, the present petition be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous and respondent no.2 be bound by the statement made before this Court. It is prayed that in case any cause survives or arises in future, liberty be granted to the petitioner to revive the same.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. Respondent no.2 would be bound by the statement made before this Court. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the same in case any cause survives.
