The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 14.05.2019, vide which operation of the order dated 08.03.2019, repatriating the petitioner to parent State of Haryana as well as the relieving order and 20.03.2019 was stayed.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the relieving order was passed on 20.03.2019 i.e. after two months of passing of the order dated 14.05.2019 by this Court and by that time, the petitioner has already joined back his parent department. It is further submitted that even an application has been moved before the writ Court for modification of the said

order and there was no direction that the petitioner be joined back in U.T.
Chandigarh.

Be whatsoever, on the face of it, there is no willful disobedience.
