The present petition has been filed for seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly concedes that no FIR has been registered against the petitioner so far and that only a complaint has been submitted by the complainant which does not give any details regarding the time or period during which the alleged transaction had taken place. Even the said complaint was submitted on 21.02.2023. During the pendency of the application before the Sessions Judge, Kapurthala, the said fact was noticed that no FIR has been registered against the applicant-petitioner so far. The application was thus dismissed as premature/infructuous at that stage. Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly concedes that no FIR has yet been registered against the petitioner and that she only apprehends coercive action at the hands of the police since a complaint has been filed against her.

In view of the above, I find that the present petition is premature as no cause of action arises therefrom.

Disposed of accordingly at this stage.
