The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for the grant of anticipatory bail in case registered vide FIR No.159 dated 06.09.2020 under Sections 302, 460, 323, 148, 149 IPC registered at P.S. Mamdot, District Ferozepur.

On 14.06.2023 the following order was passed:-

“ *Notice of motion for 06.07.2023.*

On asking of the Court, Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and seeks time to have instructions or file response in the matter.

Requisite copies of paper book be supplied to learned State Counsel during the course of day.”

On 17.07.2023 the following order was passed:-

“ *The learned Counsel for the petitioner contends that the*

petitioner was found to be innocent during investigation and has now been summoned under Section 319 Cr.PC as an additional accused to face trial.

Adjourned to 29.08.2023.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of 07 days from today and on his surrendering, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.”

On 29.08.2023 the following order was passed:-

“ The Counsel for the State submits that in terms of the order dated 17.07.2023 passed by this Court the petitioner has surrendered before the Trial Court and has since been released on interim bail.

List on 25.09.2023.

In the meanwhile, the counsel for the parties are directed to place on record the order whereby the petitioner was admitted to interim bail pursuant to the order dated 17.07.2023 passed by this Court.”

On 25.09.2023 the following order was passed:-

“ In the interest of justice, adjourned to 26.09.2023.

To be shown in the Urgent Cause List.

Let the learned Counsel for the petitioners be intimated about the next date of hearing.”

On 29.08.2023, 25.09.2023, 26.09.2023 and today once again none has appeared on behalf of the petitioners.

The Counsel for the State however has placed on record an order dated 24.7.2021 Mark-‘A’ as per which the petitioners have appeared before the Trial Court and have been admitted to interim bail.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed

by this Court.
