The present writ petition has been filed for issuance of directions to the respondents to grant higher pay scale to the petitioners with all consequential benefits i.e. arrears of pay, interest etc., at par with junior counterparts, who have been given higher pay in terms of Rule-8 of the HCS Revised Pay Rules, 2008.

Written statement on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, by way of affidavit of the District Elementary Education Officer, Mewat, Haryana, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Copy of the same has been supplied to the counsel opposite.

A perusal of the written statement would show that pay benefits have been granted to petitioners No.1 to 4, 8, 12 and 14 whereas petitioners No.6, 7, 9, 10, 11 and 13 have failed to provide the requisite information qua their juniors belonging to the same cadre of their

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respective districts, who have been given the benefits of higher pay scale. So far as petitioner No.5 is concerned, there is no such employee in District Narnaul.

Learned State counsel very fairly submits that the petitioners who have not been granted the pay benefits by the respondents, may move a fresh representation before the competent authority, by pointing out the names of their juniors belonging to the same cadre of their respective districts, who have been given the benefits of higher pay scale in terms of Rule 8 of the HCS Revised Pay Rules, 2008.

Learned counsel for the petitioners agrees to the aforesaid offer made by the learned State counsel.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioners, except for petitioners No.1 to 4, 8, 12 and 14, to move a fresh representation before the competent authority, by pointing out the names of their juniors belonging to the same cadre of their respective districts, who have been given the benefits of higher pay scale in terms of Rule 8 of the HCS Revised Pay Rules, 2008. If such a representation is moved, the competent authority shall decide the same within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order, in accordance with law.
