Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking an innocuous relief in form of directions to the trial Court to dispose off the complaint filed by the petitioner under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act.

2. Counsel representing the petitioner refers to zimni orders from 06.01.2022 to 02.06.2023 to submit that the matter is being delayed by the accused deliberately by moving repeated applications seeking exemption from personal hearing.

3. Without commenting on the merits of the case and in view of the fact that expeditious disposal of the complaint is in the interest of both the parties, the present petition is disposed off with the direction to the trial Court to dispose off the complaint within this year i.e. before 22.12.2023, in accordance with law.

4. Keeping in view the nature of relief claimed and granted hereinabove, this Court does not find any need to issue formal notice to the respondent. However, in case the respondent feels that it was necessary to hear her, she is granted liberty to move an appropriate

application.
