- 1. The Competent Statutory Authority is directed to most expeditiously make a lawful speaking decision, upon a petition constituted under Section 11 of The Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961. Moreover, the Competent Statutory Authority is also directed to make a lawful speaking order on any application seeking stay of the auction proceedings, as have been initiated at the instance of the Authority concerned.
- 2. The parties are directed to maintain *status-quo* in respect of the disputed lands, but only uptill a period of one week.
- 3. Disposed of accordingly.
