Prayer in the present petition is for quashing the order of learned Collector dated 03.04.2015 (Annexure P-7), order of the learned Assistant Collector 2nd Grade, Bass, Hansi, Hissar, dated 08.05.2013 (Annexure P-4) and Naksha Khaa dated 22.05.2013 (Annexure P-5) being against the mode desired in the partition application and against actual possession and being arbitrary, unconstitutional and irregular and being not in accordance with the provisions of the Punjab Land Revenue Act.

A perusal of the file shows that the case is pending since the year 2015 and on majority of the dates, the petitioners were not represented.

Learned counsel for respondents No.7 to 13 has submitted that he has instructions to say that both the sides have amicably resolved their outstanding issues and in view of the same nothing survives in the present petition for adjudication.

The case came up for hearing on 16.03.2020, but no one was present on behalf of the petitioners. Thereafter, it was taken on 15.03.2023 and again the petitioners were not represented. Today also the situation remains the same. It appears that the petitioners are no more interested in pursuing the present petition.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
