RAVI SHANKER JHA, C.J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners have filed this petition being aggrieved by the fact that the respondents authorities are not processing their application for grant of NOC to commence a pharmacy course in the petitioners' institution.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to previous orders passed by this Court in CWP-5012-2023, the respondents authorities had considered petitioners' application and issued a fresh notice pointing out certain deficiencies on 13.04.2023. It is submitted that said deficiencies have been removed and thereafter though the respondents/ authorities were required to inspect the petitioner's College and process the application seeking grant of NOC, but the authorities have not done so. Hence, this petition.

3. Learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the State of Haryana, on advance copy, submits that respondents authorities are processing the petitioners’ application and in the meanwhile, they are also in the process of finalizing the Pharmacy Policy for establishing new Self Financing Technical Institute for Diploma and UG/PG Level Courses of Pharmacy. He submits that the said policy will be finalized within a period of six weeks and thereafter the application filed by the applicants (petitioners) would be considered within two weeks. He, therefore, submits that the petition at hand be disposed of taking the said statement on record.

4. In view of the fact that the petitioners’ application is pending with the respondents authorities, and the statement is being made that the same would be considered immediately on finalization of the Pharmacy Policy, the petition is disposed of in terms of the statement made by learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana. It goes without saying that in case the petitioners still aggrieved, they would be at liberty to take up fresh proceedings in accordance with law.
