The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.687 dated 07.09.2016 under Sections 420, 406 and 506 IPC registered at P.S. Sector 7, District Faridabad.

In this case the arrest of the petitioner was stayed way back in the year 2019.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that subsequently petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Sandeep Kumar submits that the petitioner has joined investigation on 08.02.2019 itself and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, no case for custodial interrogation is made out and the petitioner is granted the benefit of anticipatory bail and the

same is confirmed too.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
