KARAMJIT SINGH, J.

Prayer is for grant for anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case having FIR No.0099 dated 17.04.2021 registered under Sections 380 IPC, Police Station Mullana, District Ambala, Haryana.

The allegations in nutshell are that complainant Pardeep Kumar is having dog kennel and petitioner and his wife committed theft of 4 dogs from there.

The counsel for the petitioner submits that both the parties are running dog kennels and dispute arose between them with regard to business dealing and the petitioner and his wife are falsely

implicated in this case at the instance of complainant. The counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner has joined the investigation with the police in compliance of previous order of this Court.

The State counsel on instructions from ASI Krishan Pal submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and is not required for any further investigation or custodial interrogation by the police.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, present petition is allowed and order granting interim bail dated 06.09.2021 to the petitioner is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Even in future the petitioner should join further investigation as and when asked to do so by the police.

Disposed of accordingly, so also the pending miscellaneous application(s), if any.
