The petitioners seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.238 dated 11.11.2022 registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 468, 471, 120-B, 201 IPC read with Section 66-D of Information Technology(Amendment) Act, 2008 at Police Station Kotwali Patiala, District Patiala, Punjab.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 13.06.2023, the petitioners have joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.
