This is an application seeking condonation of delay of 24 days in filing the revision petition.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and delay of 24 days in filing the revision petition stands condoned.

CRR(F)-624-2022 (O&M)

The petition is for setting aside the order dated 20.05.2022 passed by the Principal Judge, Family Court, Sangrur, granting interim maintenance of Rs.10,000/- per month to the respondent-wife, and Rs.6,000/- per month to the minor child, apart from litigation expenses of Rs.10,000/-.

2. Pursuant to the order dated 22.07.2022 passed by this Court, an affidavit of assets and liabilities has been filed by the petitioner, stating his monthly income to be Rs.80,000/- per month. There is nothing on record to establish that the respondent-wife has sufficient income to maintain herself and her minor daughter.

3. Keeping in view the admitted income of the petitioner, as also the fact that the respondent-wife is not having sufficient income to maintain herself, the interim maintenance granted to the respondents by the impugned order cannot be termed to be on a higher side.
4. Dismissed.
