Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to re-consider the decision dated 27.07.2006 in view of the subsequent facts as the petitioner has received information under the Right to Information Act, 2006, that the driving license issued to him, is genuine.

By order dated 30.10.2018, this Court directed the State to take a final decision on Annexures P-11 and P-12, which pertain to the driving license of the petitioner. Matter has been considered by the authorities and an order dated 10.12.2018, which has been placed on record as Annexure R-7 has been passed holding that as the petitioner was less than 20 years of age, heavy vehicle driving license issued to him, is invalid.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to assail order dated 10.12.2018, Annexure R-7 before an appropriate forum.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
