On 14.06.2023, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C has been made for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0582 dated 10.08.2022 registered under Sections 379B, 341, 365, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station City Rohtak, Haryana.

FIR was lodged on complaint of Smt. Kamlesh, the mother of Ravi. As per the allegations, Lady Constable Daya was in live in relationship with Ravi. It is alleged that on 31.03.2022 said Daya along with her sister Bhawna and other accomplices kidnapped Ravi on motorcycle No.HR-12AP-2467.

It is contended by learned counsel that petitioner is nowhere named in the FIR. His name has surfaced in the disclosure statement of co-accused Daya as per which she and Bhawna along with Manjeet and his companions had snatched the motor-cycle of Ravi and kidnapped him. Learned counsel further contends that co-accused Bhawna has already been allowed interim bail by co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 17.05.2023,in CRM-M-24951 of 2023.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Randhir Singh, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent- State.

Adjourned to 30.10.2023.

To be heard along with CRM-M-24951 of 2023.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, as pointed above, but without commenting on the merits of the case, detailed status report be filed on behalf of the respondent- State, on or before the date fixed.

In the meantime, in case of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/ Investigating Officer. However, it is further directed that the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when so required by the Investigating Officer. He shall not contact any person associated with the case to dissuade him from the investigation in any manner whatsoever and nor shall leave the country without prior permission of the Court. He shall further comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Today, it is informed by learned State Counsel, on instructions from SI Budh Singh, that in compliance of the order dated 14.06.2023, petitioner has since joined the investigation and he is no longer required for any investigation.

In view of the afore-said statement, order dated 14.06.2023 whereby interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner in the FIR in question, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer and make compliance of the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
