Prayer in the present Criminal writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents.

It is stated that private respondent Nos.4 to 8 used to harass and threatened the petitioner to either transfer his land in the name of respondent Nos.4 & 5 or they will implicate him in false cases.

Precisely, in the context of aforesaid relief, petitioner has approached the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur-respondent No.2 by way of representation dated 07.06.2023 (Annexure P-1), but no action has been taken thereon. He submits that petitioner would be satisfied if his representation dated 07.06.2023 is decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Anmol Singh Sandhu, A.A.G., Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State. A copy of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and on perusal of the paper book, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, to look into the representation dated 07.06.2023 (Annexure P-1) filed by the petitioner and if necessary to take appropriate action on the same, as per law as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of one month.
