The petitioner-Bank is alleging violation of the order dated 25.02.2020, passed by this Court in CWP-4916-2020, vide which, respondent Nos. 1 to 3 were directed to hand over the physical possession of the mortgage property to the petitioner-Bank and respondent No. 2 was directed to provide police help in this regard.

As per affidavit of the District Magistrate, Ludhiana, detailing the multiple litigation pending before the Courts, it is stated that the Civil Court has granted stay on 03.09.2019 against the delivery of the possession of the mortgage property and thereafter, the petitioner-Bank has not informed the District Magistrate despite issuance of letters about the vacation of the stay order.

In view of the same, the present petition is dismissed.

Rule stands discharged.
