This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned rejection letter bearing No.KCL/Laws/47/S.K./2017 dated 09.05.2017 (Annexure P-4) issued by the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondent-University has pointed out that in the present case, in pursuance of the order dated 15.05.2017, the petitioner was provisionally admitted to appear in the 8th semester of LL.B. (five year course) examination but thereafter the petitioner had neither attended the classes of 9th or 10th semester and did not follow up her studies nor has the petitioner made any prayer before any Court with respect to 9th and 10th semester examination and thus, she could not complete her course and even the total period of seven years within which the course has to be completed, has also elapsed and thus present petition has become infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the present petition be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous but liberty be granted to the petitioner to move a representation to the respondent-University in case the petitioner has any grievance left.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with the aforesaid liberty.
