On 14.06.2023, the following order was passed by this

Court:-

“Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.58 dated 04.05.2023 registered under Sections 336, 323, 149 of the IPC and Section 25/27/29 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Vairoke, District Fazilka.

2. Allegations are that petitioner with others way-laid Surinder Singh and his neighbour Kulwant Singh had sprayed bullets on them. It is alleged that one bullet hit the finger of Surinder Singh and another bullet hit left arm of Kulwant Singh.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner has been falsely implicated. He has drawn attention towards the MLR of both the injured Surinder Singh and that of Kulwant Singh which simply shows one injury each in the form of abrasions. There is no injury caused by firearm to any of the injured as per the MLR.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Ms. Ramta K. Chaudhary, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent- State and seeks time to file the detailed status report.

6. Adjourned to 19.09.2023.

7. In case of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. However, it is directed that the

petitioner shall join the investigation as and when so required by the Investigating Officer. He shall not contact any person associated with the case to dissuade him from the investigation in any manner whatsoever and nor shall leave the country without prior permission of the Court. He shall further comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

On instructions from ASI Lakhmir Singh, learned State counsel has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 14.06.2023 and is no longer required for further investigation.

In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 14.06.2023, whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, he shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
