The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for setting aside the order dated 11.04.2022 (Annexure P-2) vide which the bail of the petitioner was cancelled.

On 09.08.2022 while issuing notice of motion this Court had directed the petitioner to appear before the learned trial Court and in case the petitioner appears then no coercive steps shall be taken against him and thereafter in case, he files any application for grant of bail, then the same shall be considered and decided as early as possible. Thereafter, the time was extended by this Court on 29.09.2022.

Learned State counsel has submitted on instructions from ASI Gurmej Singh that the petitioner has now surrendered and, therefore, nothing survives in the present petition.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by the learned State

counsel, the present petition is disposed of.

However, since the learned counsel for the petitioner is not present in the Court today, in case any further cause of action survives, then liberty is granted to the petitioner to file any application for revival of the present petition.
