1. Annexure P-3, encloses an order made by the Rural Development and Panchayat Department, SAS Nagar, Mohali, with disclosures' that the bid of the highest bidder namely one Mahant Shiv Narayan Parkash, Dera Baba Aapo Aap Chintawala, Sarprast Baba Aapo Aap Guru Nanak Public School under Aapo Aap Educational Society (registered), became accepted, hence for lease qua thereto of the petition lands, being made, but for the purpose of running a school.

2. The grievance as ventilated by the petitioner, is that, a change has occurred in the nomenclature of the bidder, inasmuch as, the words "Sarprast Baba Aapo Aap Guru Nanak Public School under Aapo Aap Educational Society (registered)" have been wrongly added in front of the words "Mahant Shiv Narayan Parkash Dera Baba Aapo Aap Chintawala." Therefore, a mandamus is asked to be made upon the respondents concerned, to make a correction hence to bring it in consonance with the description of the bidder, as per records.

3. Further, Annexure P-4 encloses an enquiry being made in the above respect. Its perusal does unfold, that as a matter of fact, the nomenclature or the name assigned to the highest bidder, was wrongly mentioned by the Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Nabha while writing letter No. 389 dated 26.08.2015. If so, for removing any confusion in the name of the bidder, and, to also obviate that no further legal complications arise therefrom, this Court deems it fit and appropriate to direct the respondents concerned, to bring the name of the highest bidder, the petitioner herein in consonance both with records of the bid process, and, with enquiry report Annexure P-4.
4. The above correction be made within a period of three weeks in the relevant register, and, records maintained for the relevant purpose by the respondents concerned.
5. Disposed of accordingly.
