MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of direction to respondent no. 2 and 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners.

2. Reply by way of affidavit of Manoj Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Gharaunda, District Karnal, has been filed. The same is taken on record. Copy of the same be supplied to other side during course of the day.

3. This Court has gone through the aforesaid affidavit. The para 3 thereof reads as under:-

“3. That Ram Avtar, Sub Inspector No. 255/ KR, Police Station Gharaunda was deputed in the matter. On 01.07.2023, Ram Avtar Sub Inspector called Pinki and Tarun (respondent No. 6 and 7) residents of Gandhi Colony, Panipat, Haryana, telephonically, who came present in the Police Station. Sub Inspector Ram Avtar joined Tarun and recorded the statement, who stated that he is having younger sister Simran (petitioner No.1), who is 7 standard pass and left school 8-9 months ago. Simran (petitioner No.1) left house on 28.04.2023 at 6.00 A.M. without disclosing anything to any body. FIR No. 155 dated 28.04.2023 Under Section-365 of Indian Penal

Code, Police Station Model Town, Panipat was got registered. After making enquiry, they came to know that his sister Simran (petitioner No.1) had been enticed by Shubham (petitioner No.2) son of Subhash resident of Village Alipura, Police Station Gharaunda, District Karnal. He had also enticed his sister Simran (petitioner No.1) 3-4 times, but both have admitted their mistake. Tarun respondent No.7 has assured that there is no danger to petitioner No.1 Simran and petitioner No.2- Shubham from him and his family members. The statement has been signed by Tarun and attested by Ram Avtar Sub Inspector, Police Station Gharaunda. ...”

Perusal of the above reveals that there is no threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

4. In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed off.
5. Needless to say that in case the occasion so arises, petitioners would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy available under law.
