The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.90 dated 04.04.2023 registered under Section 18 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Special Task Force, Phase- 4, Mohali, District STF Wing.

2. It is contended by learned counsel that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case and alleged recovery 2 kilogram of opium falls in the non-commercial category. Learned counsel further contends that petitioner has no criminal antecedents and so, he be allowed bail as trial may take time to conclude.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Randeep Singh Khaira, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent- State.

5. Custody certificate has been placed on record by learned State counsel as per which petitioner is in custody for the last 03 months and 20

days with no criminal antecedents. Learned State counsel concedes that recovered quantity of contraband falls in the non-commercial category.

6. Having regard the aforesaid facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
