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As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.8,00,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellants. Learned counsel for the appellants further stated that the entire enhanced amount be paid to all the appellants in the ratio of 60:20:20, in full & final satisfaction of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit three cheques; one in the sum of Rs.4,00,000/- favouring appellant No.1-Kanta Devi Wd/o Sham Lal and two cheques in the sum of Rs.2,00,000/- each favouring appellants 2 and 3-Narinder Kumar and Rakesh Kumar respectively, with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 31.08.2023. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
