Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India by the petitioner seeking issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondent No. 5 to declare the result of post of sales man cum cashier which was advertised by respondent No. 5 vide advertisement dated 25.01.2023 (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner being a competent candidate and fulfilling the criteria as mentioned in the advertisement dated 25.01.2023 applied for the above said post and was called for interview and was selected by the committee. Thereafter respondent No. 5 did not declare the result and no action was even taken by respondent No. 3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 03.03.2023 (Annexure P-7), which is still pending consideration with

respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a

direction is issued to respondent No. 3 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, on the asking of the Court, Mr. Anurag Bansal, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 03.03.2023 in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.

In view of the pleadings in the present petition, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioners in the legal notice, respondents are directed to decide the representation dated 03.03.2023 (Annexure P-7), by passing a speaking order within a period of four weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of.
