RITU TAGORE, J.(Oral)

1. Mr. Ankit Bhardwaj, Advocate appears on behalf of respondent No.4 and files Power of attorney, which is taken on record, subject to just exceptions.

2. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos.4 and 5.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that a compromise has been arrived at between petitioners and respondents No.4 and 5 and petitioner No.1 now has no perception of threat from her family members.

4. Learned counsel for the State has placed on record the statement of Ritu-petitioner No.1 wherein she has stated that now her

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family has accepted her relations with Varinder Singh and she does not want to pursue with the writ petition.

5. Learned counsel for respondent No.4 verifies the aforesaid factum of compromise.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioners therefore, wishes to withdraw this petition.

7. In view of the above, petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
