1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the action of the respondents whereby junior employees to the petitioners have been called for work without maintaining the seniority list of seasonal workers.

2. At this stage, counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents herein would submit that the writ petition as filed by petitioner No.1-Udaibir Singh and petitioner No.2-Mahesh Kumar ought to be dismissed with costs considering they have concealed the fact that they have already approached this Court by way of filing CWP No.23971 of 2018. It is also submitted that de hors the argument for dismissal with costs, petitioners No.1 and 2 stood regularized w.e.f. 06.01.2021 as would be evident from Annexure R-1 annexed with the written statement of the respondents. It is submitted that

during the proceedings of this case, petitioner No.3-Hari Ram has also been regularized vide office order dated 25.08.2021 as would be evident from office order dated 25.08.2021. Photocopy of the order is taken on record.

3. No one has put in the appearance on behalf of the petitioners. Same was the position on the last two consecutive hearings.

4. In view of above, the writ petition qua petitioners No.1 and 2 stands dismissed whereas no further orders are called for qua petitioner No.3 who already stands regularized and the writ petition qua him as well stands disposed of.
