The petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus to direct the respondents to take him back in service with continuity of service. He claims to have been appointed as a Peon by the Panchayat Samiti, Samrala, which has been constituted in accordance with Chapter IX of the Constitution of India. It is evident that the petitioner was recruited through an outsourcing agency. The previous writ petition filed by the petitioner i.e CWP-766-2015 was dismissed as withdrawn. The petitioner's services have been dispensed with as a regularly appointed Peon has been posted in his place. In such circumstances, no ground to issue the writ, as prayed for.

Hence, dismissed.
