The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.363 dated 27.04.2023 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 307, 506 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act registered at P.S. Samalkha, Panipat.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 13.09.2023 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Sethan Pal submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 13.09.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 13.09.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation

as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
