RITU TAGORE, J.(Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos.4 and 5, as they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members.

2. Learned counsel for the State has placed on record the statement made by petitioner No.1-Seema to the respect that now she has no threat from her mother-Raj Bala, respondent No.5 and all her other family members have accepted her marriage with Shiv Kumar-petitioner No.2. The affidavit of Shiv Kumar has also been placed on record by learned State counsel wherein he has stated that petitioner No.1 has gone to UK on 17.06.2023 for her studies and now he has no threat perception from anyone. Neither anyone has any objection with respect to his marriage with petitioner No.1-Seema. Copy of the aforesaid statement and affidavit has been supplied to the counsel for

the petitioners.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the statement of petitioner No.1 and affidavit of petitioner No.2, he does not wish to continue with the present petition and withdraws the same.

4. In view of above, petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
