VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 08.07.2016 (Annexure P-11) passed by respondent Nos.5 and 6 whereby the lady officials SWAN Operators-petitioners have been directed to perform round the clock duty as per duty roster.

2. On 09.01.2017, a Coordinate Bench of this Court had passed the following order:-

“On the last date the following order was passed:-

“Counsel appearing for the petitioners would submit that the matter as regards redressal of the grievance of the petitioners is under active consideration with the respondent/competent authority.

He, accordingly, prays for hearing in the instant

petition to be deferred.

On his request, adjourned to 09.01.2017.”

Learned counsel prays that the present petition be adjourned sine die with liberty to the petitioners to revive the same when a decision is taken by the Competent Court.

Allowed as prayed for. Adjourned sine die.
