The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.114 dated 03.06.2023 under Sections 62, 65 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 and Section 77 of the Juvenile Justice Act, 2015 and 201 IPC registered at Police Station Ranjiv Avenue Amritsar, District Amritsar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim orders dated 16.06.2023 and 18.10.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
