1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in:-

2. Counsel for the complainant submits that the dispute has been amicably settled and a petition seeking quashing is in the process of being instituted.

3. Upon instructions received from ASI, Harjinder Singh, State counsel submits that pursuant to interim order dated 16.06.2023 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined and cooperated with the investigation. He has instructions to state that he is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

4. In view of the above, but without commenting upon the merits of the allegations, petition is allowed. Order dated 16.06.2023 is made absolute subject to satisfaction of conditions laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
