VIVEK PURI, J.(ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking regular bail in the case bearing FIR
No. 120 dated 21.08.2019 under Section 21 of the NDPS Act registered at
Police Station Sadar Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

2. Custody certificate has been placed on record.

3. As per the allegations, the petitioner was found in possession of
980 intoxicant tablets.

4. As per the report of FSL, the Tramadol Hydrochloride was
found in the contents of that tablets and the weight comes to 402.78 grams.

5. Learned State counsel, on instructions from H.C.Harvarinder
Singh, submits that the case in the trial Court is fixed for defence evidence.

6. As the trial in the case is at fag end and moreover, the petitioner
was involved in the present case when he was on bail in another case under
the NDPS Act, no ground is made out to extend the concession of bail to
the petitioner.
