By way of present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioners are seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 8.

As per the petitioners, they have married on 14.06.2023 against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 8, who are family members/ relatives of petitioner No.1 i.e. Amritpal Kaur.

Both the petitioners have claimed themselves to be major by relying upon their Aadhar Cards indicating that the petitioner No.1- Amritpal Kaur is 09.05.1998 born and petitioner No.2-Rasal Singh is 05.11.1997 born.

Without commenting on the legality and validity of the marriage, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent No.2 (Senior

Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran) to look into the representation dated 14.06.2023 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioners. Respondent No.2 (Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran) shall take necessary steps to ensure protection of life and liberty of the petitioners.

The petition stands disposed off.
